 - How can we network with existing education-related groups on Princeton's campus?

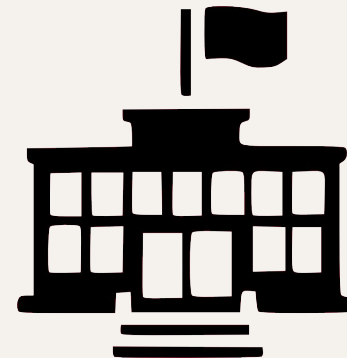
❖ PES will consist of two essential functions:

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Preparatory Function

Some objectives of PES will reflect those of other pre-professional groups:

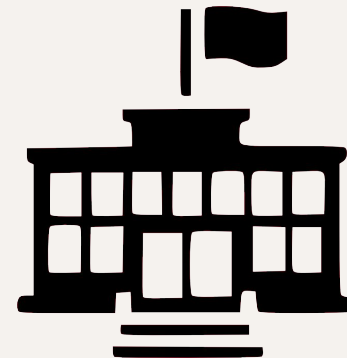
- ❖ Bring students interested in careers in education (in primary and secondary schools, academia and research, non-profits, government, etc.) in contact with relevant alumni and other accessible professionals
- ❖ Provide support for Princeton undergraduates planning graduate school and professional pathways related to education



Preparatory Function

Immediate goals for Spring 2024:

- ❖ Host speakers who can discuss educational careers and/or graduate schools of education
- ❖ Create opportunities bulletin accessible by Princeton undergraduate community: careers, summer experiences, people willing to network with students, etc.
- ❖ Streamlining access to internship opportunities



Productive Function

PES will also seek to become a Research-Focused Student Initiative

- ❖ Foster discussion on educational research from
 - Organizing/attending monthly discussions on campus about recent educational research

- ❖ Collaborate with current Princeton Educational Service organizations
 - Community House After School Program
 - Academic Success Today
 - Matriculate

- ❖ Evaluating the methods of education implemented by Princeton University and discussing whether or not effective pedagogy is being utilized by the institution

Productive Function

Immediate goals for Spring 2024:

- ❖ Set up communication lines with student organizations on campus that might collaborate with us in Fall 2025 (ex: Pace Center groups)
- ❖ Determine members' literature interests and coordinate speaker events/group discussions relevant to these interests
